### EXAMINATION INSTRUCTIONS AND FEBRUARY & MAY 2026 SCHEDULE

#### **1.0 GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS AND SCHEDULE OF EXAMINATION**

**Please read the following instructions carefully to ensure a smooth examination process. Adherence to these guidelines is mandatory, and failure to comply may result in disqualification or other penalties:**

1. Each paper is allotted a duration of two (2) hours;
2. All morning examination sessions will start at 9.00 a.m. and afternoon examination sessions will start at 2.00 p.m.;
3. Candidates **MUST** attend rehearsal in person at the designated examination center and complete both mock exams before being admitted to the main examination;
4. Attendance at the rehearsal is **MANDATORY**; failure to attend may result in disqualification from sitting the main examination;
5. **Attendance of rehearsal shall constitute being physically present, taking the mock exam in the examination system, receiving the NCK examination card and signing the attendance record provided.**
6. The deadline for changing the examination center shall be three (3) weeks prior to the rehearsal date;
7. There shall be **NO ADMISSION** into the exam room without presenting the necessary identification i.e. National ID, and NCK Exam Card;
8. All candidates are expected to adhere to a professional dress code during the examination. Candidates trained in Kenya, must wear either their school uniform or the nurses/midwives' official uniform and avoid revealing or casual attire. Adherence to appropriate dress code is mandatory and failure to comply may result in removal from the exam center.
9. The exam shall be undertaken at the designated examination centre;
10. Any request to take the exam remotely must be submitted to the Council in writing at least two (2) weeks before the rehearsal date. The request must include supporting documentation to justify the need for remote examination. The Council will review the same for merit and reserves the right to either grant or deny the request;
11. Arrive at your assigned seat in the examination room one (1) hour before the scheduled start time for each paper;

12. Punctuality is essential; any candidate arriving more than 30 minutes after the start of the examination will not be permitted to sit for it;
13. The Council must be officially notified of any withdrawal from the examination within the designated timeframe as per the annexed exam schedule;
14. Immediate termination of examination upon detection of any restricted application”.
15. You are **NOT PERMITTED** to bring any unauthorized materials into the examination room, including but not limited to notes, books, and reference materials. All prohibited materials **MUST** be left outside the examination room or in designated storage areas;
16. The use of mobile phones, iPads, smartwatches, ear phones/buds, Bluetooth devices except for mice any other electronic devices, except for the Personal Computer (PC) being used for the exam, is strictly prohibited in the examination rooms. Violators will be immediately disqualified from the examination;
17. During the examination, candidates **MUST** ensure that only the designated online examination application is open on their device. No other documents, applications, or browsers are permitted to be running in the background. It is the candidates' responsibility to ensure that their device is free of any unauthorized applications or materials **BEFORE** starting the exam. Failure to ensure this will be deemed as an exam irregularity;
18. There will be immediate termination of examination upon detection of any restricted application (as indicated in No. 17 above);
19. Leaving the exam environment or receiving remote assistance is strictly prohibited during the exam session. Violators will be immediately disqualified from the examination;
20. Disorderly conduct or any disturbance by an examinee in or near the examination venue will be considered a serious examination irregularity and will be dealt with accordingly;
21. Any candidate found to be involved in examination malpractice will face automatic cancellation of their results for that examination cycle;
22. Any candidate caught engaging in examination malpractice will be prohibited from sitting for any examinations for a period of one (1) year from the date of the incident; and
23. No requests for a refund of the examination fee will be considered for candidates who fail to adhere to the established examination rules and regulations.

*The Council reserves the right to review exam submissions to ensure compliance with **ALL** the above instructions and requirements. Any failure to adhere to these standards may affect the final assessment outcome.*
